### What memberships do you need to show:

VRHA Green As Grass, VRHA Green Rider, VRHA Beginner, Come & Try classes require:

VRHA Membership. For VRHA Come and Try classes a day fee is available. Only 2 Day memberships per rider per year can be taken, after the 2nd Day Membership issued a full VRHA membership is to be applied for to show, as a new member initiative the Day membership fee will deducted from the Full Membership Fee in the same show year.

**NRHA MEMBERS**: Please check your NRHA membership type and is current for the show, along with checking eligibility on the NRHA Reiner Suite to ensure that you are eligible to compete in a chosen division

NRHA members who enter NRHA classes and not a member of VRHA, \$15 event levy will be applied for insurance purposes

Sunday 26th January show is NRHA approved. NRHA Riders/NRHA Licensed horses can QUALIFY for the 202 NRHA Oceania Affiliate Championships as per 202 Qualifying conditions

(Novice Horse classes do not required qualifying)

Pattern 14/14A Any Handed: Rider can choose to ride either one or two handed and swap at any time, simple or flying lead changes permitted. Rider can choose to ride P14 with a lead change or P 14 A with no lead change. Open to all levels of horse /Rider combinations. Horse does not need to meet requirements of NRHA ownership.

VRHA Green As Grass, Come & Try Reining: For horse and Non Pro rider combinations who are new to Reining. A rider who has entered an NRHA Class at this show is not eligible except NRHA Green Reiner L1/L2

<u>Pattern 99 Come & Try Reining</u>: For horse/rider combinations who are new to Reining. A rider who has entered any NRHA class is not eligible

Rider can choose to ride either one or two handed and swap at any time.

Horse does not need to meet requirements of NRHA ownership. Western, English or stock saddle ,snaffle bit or bridle, western attire, long sleeve shirt.

**VRHA Green Rider, VRHA Beginner,:** For horse and Non Pro rider combinations who are new to Reining, where a rider starts the year in VRHA Green Rider, VRHA Beginner the rider is eligible for the remainder of the show year.

Rider can choose to rider either one or two handed and swap at any time, Pattern to be ridden at the lope. Horse does not need to meet requirements of NRHA horse ownership, Western saddle, snaffle bit or bridle, western attire, long sleeve shirt is required.

## Pattern 14 A is Pattern 14 modified

## 14A has no lead changes required at maneuver 3 & 4

### Pattern 14

Horses may walk or jog to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1.Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate

2.Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

3.Beginning on the right lead, complete two circles to the right: the first twos circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena

4.Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena

5.Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least 20 feet (6meters) from the wall or fence-no hesitation.

6. Continue around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least 20 feet (6meters) from the wall or fence-no hesitation.

7. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least 10 feet (3

meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of pattern.

### Pattern 14A

Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.

2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena.

4. Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena

5. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence

6. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence

7. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the centre marker and stop at least twenty feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence. Back up. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

### VRHA Pattern 99 (Non Sanctioned)

Horses may walk or jog to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena.

1. Beginning on the left lead, complete two circles to the left: Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.

2. Beginning on the right lead, complete two circles to the right: Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.

3. Continue around previous circle to the left but do not close this circle. Travel up the right side of the arena past the center marker, stop and demonstrate a 180 degree turn

4. Continue around previous circle but do not close this circle. travel up the left side of the arena past the center marker, stop and demonstrate a 180 degree turn continue to travel back around previous circle but do not close this circle, continue to travel up the right side of the arena past the center marker and come to a stop. Hesitate. Back up one or two steps, Hesitate to demonstrate completion of pattern.

### VRHA Pattern 5A (Non Sanctioned)

Horses may walk or jog to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena.

1. Beginning on the LEFT LEAD, complete three circles to the LEFT: the first two circles large; the third circle small. Stop at the centre of the arena.

2.Complete FOUR SPINS to the LEFT. HESITATE.

3.Beginning on the RIGHT LEAD, complete three circles to the RIGHT: the first two circles large; the third circle small . Stop at the centre of the arena.

4.Complete FOUR SPINS to the RIGHT. HESITATE.

5.Beginning on the LEFT LEAD run a large circle to the LEFT, but do not close this circle. Run up the RIGHT side of the arena past the centre marker and do a RIGHT rollback

6.Continue around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the LEFT side of the arena past the centre marker and do a LEFT ROLLBACK.

7.Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the RIGHT side of the arena past the centre marker and do a SLIDING STOP at least twenty feet (6 metres) from the wall or fence. BACK UP at least ten feet (3 metres). HESITATE to demonstrate completion of the pattern

#### **VRHA SHOW ENTRY CONDITIONS**

By entering the event, participants agree to be bound by these General Terms and Conditions and any Special Terms and Conditions appearing below.

Reining is designed to improve a horse's balance, suppleness, and flexibility, as well as improve the communication between horse and rider. In the Reining competition, riders are required to complete predetermined movements and are judged on the accuracy, suppleness and overall balance of the horse and rider. Reining patterns have been modified for the day to cater for all levels.

Western Show Attire to be worn. Safe and legal equipment is a requirement of entry,

VRHA Show Management reserves the right to refuse entry to any rider not presenting with presentable show attire or safe equipment

Cairnbrook Park Equine & Event Facility require Waiver to be completed and DPI horse movement form to be completed prior riding.

#### ARENA USAGE

Arena admittance solely for rider/s and instructors/clinicians/judges. Exception for manure removal and arena setup.

NO ADMITTANCE FOR GENERAL PUBLIC in Arenas and warm up areas

Appropriate sturdy footwear only to be worn in arena, sneakers not acceptable.

A short property orientation upon arrival will be given to all new riders

#### SECURING HORSES

No tying of horses to floats. Please use stables provided, or secured in your own temporary yards.

#### MANURE REMOVAL

Riders are responsible for the timely removal of manure from horses in their care. <u>Manure is to be taken away</u> with you upon departure.

#### Arena to be cleared of manure at all times. (Responsibility of hirer)

All riders must bring their own manure scoop.

#### STRICTLY no cleaning of floats on Cairnbrook Park property

#### CHILD SUPERVISION

Spectators are always welcome at Cairnbrook Park. Children under 12 years of age must always be in the direct care and supervision of a responsible adult.

In accordance with Victorian State Law children must not be left unsupervised in cars.

#### PET POLICY

Strictly No Pets are to be brought onto Cairnbrook Park property, this includes animals in vehicles.

NO SMOKING anywhere on Cairnbrook Park property

**<u>ALCOHOL</u>** is not to be brought onto Cairnbrook Park property.

**<u>NO CAMPING</u>** is permitted at Cairnbrook Park. You are welcome to stay overnight in your float or vehicle to care for your horse. You are not permitted to set up any camping areas outside of floats or vehicles. Toilets and shower facilities available. Camping rules are in accordance with stipulations from Wellington Shire.

#### NO POWER ONSITE

#### Please be aware you will be asked to exit the property immediately if any of these rules are not adhered to.

#### No Exceptions.

#### These rules are for the safety and comfort of all participants and we hope you enjoy your time at

#### **Cairnbrook Park**

VRHA recommends the wearing of an approved Australian Standard horse riding helmet to be worn at all times when mounted

Horses must be walked and led outside of the boundaries of the allocated covered show arena and allocated warm up arena to get to and from the float parking area

Competitors have access to the allocated warm up arena next to the covered show arena prior their class- riding is only permitted in the warm up and show arena only no lungeing in warm up areas

Riders 18 years and under are not permitted to ride stallions.

No horse under the age of 3 will be permitted to be shown

Participants must remain in the equestrian area and not enter any other areas of the grounds

Spectator areas, canteen access, gateways and exit points are kept clear at all times.

Dogs, Smoking and/or Alcohol are not permitted on the premises at any time.

All rubbish placed in the bins provided.

#### FORMAT, ENTRIES & FEES

 All competitors entering must be current financial members of VRHA either full or by way of the event membership Entries will only be accepted with full payment. Entries that do not accompany a payment will not go into the class. Complete the online entry form an entry invoice will be raised and emailed to your email address supplied on the entry form. Please check junk or spam folders if email has not been received.

- One Entry per horse: Entries will be invoiced according to nominations submitted
- All Youth 13 years & under must wear approved fastened Safety Helmets while competing and on the event grounds. Youth age 18 Years & under as at Jan1st 2022
- VRHA reserves the right to amend or alter the show program.
- SCRATCHINGS & REFUNDS FOR SCRATCHING: HORSE or RIDER (Show secretary must be notified of a scratching email vrhashowentry@outlook.com)
