2025 and 2026 NRHA Oceania Affiliate Championship

In looking towards the future and in creating stability for the event, the NRHA Oceania Affiliate Council has voted to keep the Oceania Affiliate Championship in a three-state rotation, moving the event up and down the East Coast of Australia. This means, the 2025 NRHA Oceania Affiliate Championship will take place in Queensland, with the 2026 NRHA Oceania Affiliate Championship to take place back in New South Wales. The rotation will then start back in Victoria for the 2027 event.

Come and join us for the richest reining in the world at the 2024 NRHA Futurity and Adequan® North American Affiliate Championship!




ReinerSuite Membership and Competition License Confirmations

While completing applications in ReinerSuite, please note that the confirmation of transaction receipt email serves as proof of submission for proofing for competition licenses. It is not equivalent to the completed competition license. The receipt email confirms that the application has been received and is being proofed by NRHA staff. The official competition license will be issued separately once the application(s) completes proofing.

Event Results

As technology becomes more efficient, so does NRHA! Through ReinerSuite, event approvals and event results can be processed by show secretaries immediately when they have the information or upon an event completion. NRHA show secretaries now have the ability to download an API into their show programs that can check eligibility in real time and through ReinerSuite can upload a csv of their event results immediately upon the event completing, leading to very little time between an event finishing and the results being published for members to see. Note to Show Secretaries: Event results with payouts should be published publicly for members to take note of immediately following the completion of the class.

Dressing to Impress

Schooling is a part of many reiners process when participating in events, and in many times can be very beneficial for not only our horses, but also us as riders. However, it is important to remember that when you are schooling in an official NRHA class, you are representing the sport to all that are watching you. Even if you are planning to zero your score immediately, please take care to dress yourself and your horse in a manner that is not only respectful to the judge who is present and judging you, but to the sport that you love and are representing (sometimes on a worldwide level if the event is being livestreamed).
